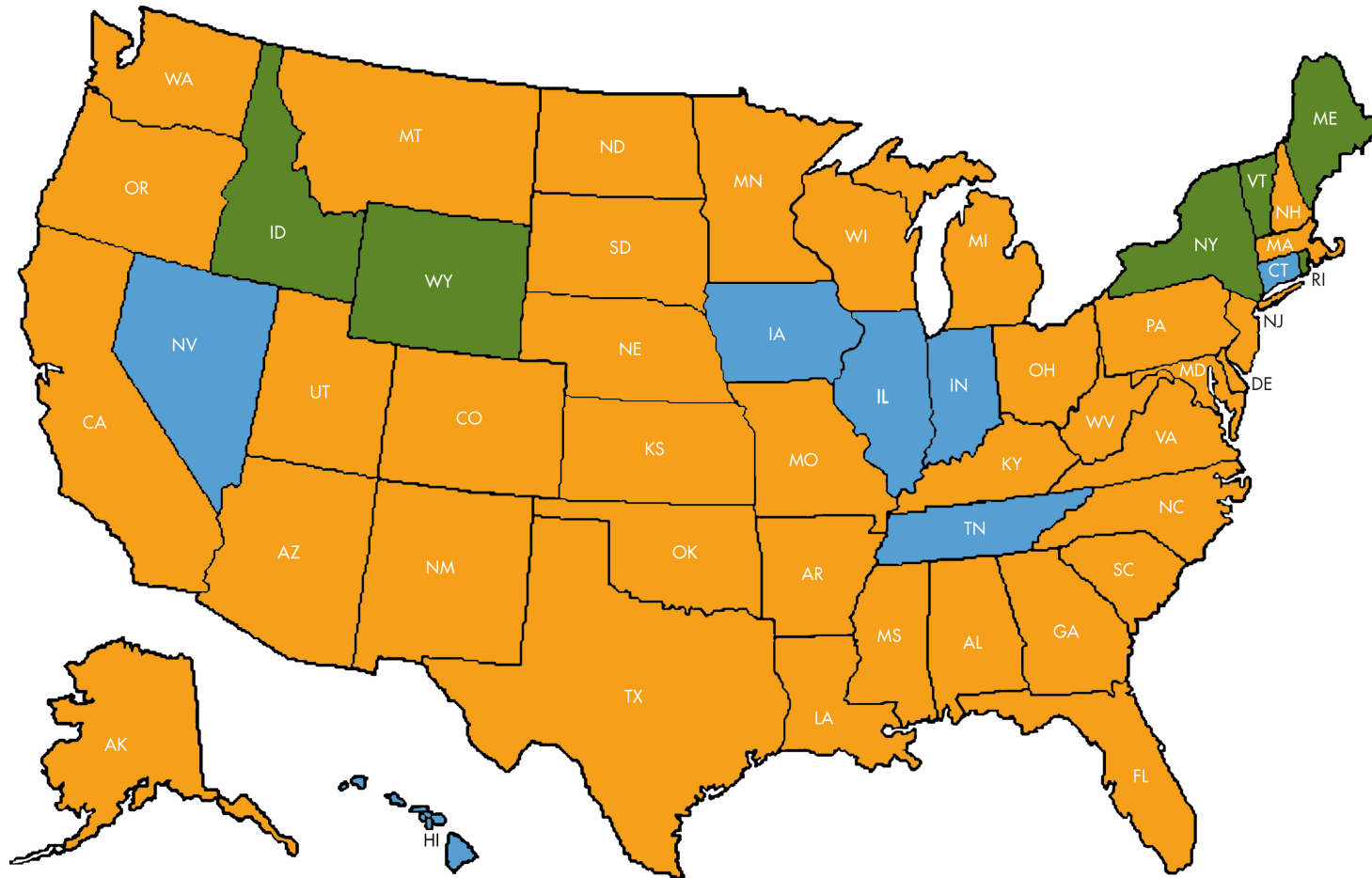




Summary of State Laws Regarding Commercialization of Bear Gallbladders*



37 States prohibit the trade of bear gallbladders — Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Virginia, Washington, West Virginia, Wisconsin

6 States allow the trade of bear gallbladders — Idaho, Maine, New York, Rhode Island, Vermont, Wyoming

7 States allow the trade of bear gallbladders from bears taken out of state — Connecticut, Hawaii, Indiana, Illinois, Iowa, Nevada, Tennessee
